## **Provisional Agenda**

## 1. Opening by the Chair, Patrick Moran, (United States of America)

The meeting will be opened by the Chair, Patrick Moran (United States of America).

## 2. Appointment of rapporteur

A rapporteur will be nominated and appointed.

### 3. Adoption of agenda

### 4. Annual compliance review 2023

The NAFO Secretariat will present the draft compilation of the fishing reports as part of the process of the Annual Compliance Review conducted by STACTIC in accordance with Rule 5.1(e) of the NAFO Rules of Procedure: Commission. Contracting Parties will be invited to review the draft compilation for completeness and accuracy.

At the 2023 Annual Meeting, STACTIC agreed that Contracting Parties will review the format of the annual compliance review and discuss the inclusion of other compliance elements, as well as the possible deletion of certain sections that are not relevant to the conclusions and recommendations section pertaining to compliance at this meeting.

## 5. NAFO MCS website and application development

The Secretariat has continued work on the MCS Website, the Observer application, and the ePSC application since the 2023 Annual meeting and will provide an update at this meeting.

#### 6. Review of Article 30 of the NAFO CEM

*The STACTIC Observer Program Review Working Group (WG-OPR) will provide an update on its tasking outlined in the revised Terms of Reference (<u>COM Doc. 23-25</u>) under this agenda item.* 

## 7. New and pending proposals on enforcement measures: Possible revisions of the NAFO CEM

This is a regular agenda item where new and pending proposals concerning the <u>NAFO CEM</u> are deliberated.

At the 2023 STACTIC Annual Meeting, it was agreed that STACTIC will continue its discussion on Canada's proposal on labeling requirements (STACTIC WP 22-25 (Rev.)) at this meeting.

## 8. Discussion on the review of Article 4 of the NAFO CEM

In accordance with Article 4.7 of the NAFO Conservation and Enforcement Measures (CEM), NAFO will review the Article 4 measures in 2024.

## 9. Review of the new measures in the yellowtail fishery

At the 2023 Annual Meeting, the NAFO Commission adopted new measures in the yellowtail fishery (<u>COM Doc. 23-12</u>) and STACTIC shall review the new measures in accordance with Article 6.11 of the 2024 <u>NAFO CEM</u>.

## 10. Half-year review of the implementation of new NAFO CEM measures

The NAFO Secretariat will report on its experience in the implementation of binding measures adopted by the Commission at the 2023 Annual Meeting, which came into force in October 2023 (NAFO 23-234 of 06 October 2023) and January 2024 (NAFO/23-249 of 28 November 2023).

Contracting Parties will be invited to report on their experience and issues encountered in the implementation of the new measures.

### **11.** Discussion on the definition of directed fisheries and bycatches

At the 2023 STACTIC Annual Meeting, it was agreed that STACTIC will start the discussion on the definition of directed fisheries and bycatches at this meeting. The Commission also noted that STACTIC, in these discussions, ensure that there is coordination with other relevant NAFO bodies where appropriate.

## 12. Practical application of Port State Measures in NAFO

At the 2023 STACTIC Annual Meeting, it was agreed that STACTIC will wait to continue the discussion on calculating the percent difference in PSC3 reports until PECMAC has reached a decision. If an update from PECMAC is available, it will be discussed under this agenda item.

## 13. Marking of gears

At the 2023 STACTIC Annual Meeting, it was agreed that NAFO Secretariat will research the vessel and gear marking requirements of other RFMOs and report back at the 2024 STACTIC Intersessional meeting.

## 14. Report and recommendations of the Editorial Drafting Group (EDG)

The Editorial Drafting Group (EDG) met on 03 November 2023 to review the 2024 draft NAFO CEM (STACTIC WP 23-27). The EDG agreed that STACTIC should discuss Article 12.6 of the <u>NAFO CEM</u> regarding the possible posting of research submissions to the public website at this meeting.

## 15. Review and evaluation of practices and procedures

It was agreed that this be a standing agenda item with the intention of providing Contracting Parties with the opportunity to share domestic Practices and Procedures. Contracting Parties are encouraged to continue to share relevant Practices and Procedures with STACTIC and to submit relevant documents to the Secretariat. The Secretariat will also provide a list of all information currently available on the Practices and Procedures webpages.

## 16. Review of current IUU list pursuant to NAFO CEM Article 53

The IUU list will be reviewed in accordance with Article 53 of the <u>NAFO CEM</u>.

## 17. Report and advice of the Joint Advisory Group on Data Management (JAGDM)

The JAGDM meeting is scheduled to take place on 24 April 2024 (originally scheduled for 23 February 2024), and an update from that meeting will be presented under this agenda item. STACTIC may also make requests to JAGDM under this agenda item.

## **18.** Implementation of the Performance Review recommendations

The Secretariat will provide an update on the implementation on the 2018 Performance Review recommendations in which STACTIC is the lead NAFO body.

## **19. STATLANT 21**

At the 2023 Annual Meeting, it was agreed that a letter be sent from the STACTIC Chair to the Scientific Council Chair requesting information on how STATLANT 21 data is being used, what data is being used and if other sources of data could be used in its place. STACTIC will continue the discussion on STATLANT 21 at their meeting following the reply from the Scientific Council Chair.

### 20. Other business

Any topics not covered by the agenda items above may be discussed under this agenda item.
