Japanese Proposal

Amendment to the Conservation and Enforcement Measures

1. A Contracting Party shall ensure that vessels of that Party to which the Scheme of Joint International Inspection applies shall report to their competent authorities:
  - (a) each entry into the Regulatory Area. This report shall be made at least six (6) hours in advance of the vessel's entry and shall include the date, the time and the geographical position of the vessel.
  - (b) each exit from the Regulatory Area and each movement from one NAFO sub-division to another NAFO sub-division. This report shall be made prior vessels exit from the Regulatory Area or entry into a NAFO sub-division and shall include the date, the time and the geographical position of the vessel.

Without prejudice to Schedule II of Part V of the NAFO Conservation and Enforcement Measures, after each radio or fax transmission of information to the competent authorities of Contracting Parties the following details are to be immediately entered in the logbook:

- Date and time of transmission
  - Name of radio station through which it was made, if it was a radio transmission.
2. Whenever possible, within 24 hours of receipt of these reports, competent authorities of each Contracting Party shall transmit the information contained therein to other Contracting Parties with an inspection presence in the Regulatory Area. The information shall also be forwarded to the Executive Secretary as soon as possible.
