Third Annual Meeting.Document No. 17.Final Record of the Payments to the Working Capital Fund

Authorized Maximum Fund Can. \$5,266.60. [According to Recommendation 6 from the Committee on Finance and Administration adopted at the Second Annual Meeting (vide Second Annual Report for the Year 1951-52, page 18)].

With France having deposited its ratification on 27 January 1953, all ten signatory Governments have entered the Commission.

The following table shows the original contribution for each country to the Working Capital Fund, together with the sums credited to the countries at the billing of the year 1952/53 and the sums to be credited at the billing of the year 1953/54 in order that the final contribution of Can. \$526.66 is effected for each country.
