IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RECOMMENDATION MADE BY THE COMMITTEE ON RESEARCH AND STATISTICS AT THEIR TWELFTH ANNUAL MEETING IN MOSCOW (1962) THAT THE LIST OF SPECIES FOR WHICH STATISTICAL REPORTS ARE REQUIRED, AND THEIR ORDER, GROUPING AND SUBTOTALLING, SHOULD BE REVIEWED AT THE NEXT ANNUAL MEETING, THE SECRETARIAT IN PREPARATION FOR THIS HAS, AS RECOMMENDED (REDBOOK 1962, PART 1, PAGE 36, (D) 11), PREPARED TABLE 3 OF THE STATISTICAL BULLETIN IN BOTH ICNAF AND FAO SPECIES ORDERS.

NOTE: THESE TABLES SUMMARIZE THE LANDINGS BY SPECIES AND SUBAREAS FOR 1961 AND ARE BASED ON THE REVISED STATISTICAL REPORTS FROM MEMBER COUNTRIES AND REPRESENT THE FINAL FIGURES ON LANDINGS. ALL LANDINGS ARE GIVEN IN METRIC TONS, ROUND FRESH WEIGHT.
