ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE, 1964

A Summary Of The Fishery In The Convention Area1952 - 1962 (inclusive)

During 1962, total landings from the Convention Area increased by about 8.3 percent, from 2400 thousand tons in 1961 to 2604 thousand tons in 1962. (This is comparative with the increase of 7.1 percent in 1959, 6.3 percent in 1960 and 5.3 percent in 1961). Increases were recorded in landings of Cod (up 36 thousand tons; 2.8 percent), Shellfish (up 15 thousand tons; 7.1 percent), Flounder (up 1 thousand tons; 1.1 percent), and Others (up 230 thousand tons; 59.4 percent). Decreases in landings took place in Haddock (down 41 thousand tons; 22.9 percent), Redfish (down 39 thousand tons; 17.3 percent), and Halibut (down 714 tons; 12.2 percent).

The comparative percentages of the total landings as taken by the various countries from the Convention Area in 1960, 1961 and 1962 are as follows:

The purpose of Tables A to E, which follow, is to assist the user in visualizing the general trend of the fisheries in the Convention Area. Table A gives a summary of total landings by species groups, countries and subareas, for the past eleven years, while Tables B, C, D and E give a summary of cod, haddock, redfish and halibut landings by countries and subareas for the same period. The more detailed break-downs are given in Tables 1 to 5 in Part II of the Statistical Bulletin, Volume 12 which was submitted to the printer in April, 1964.

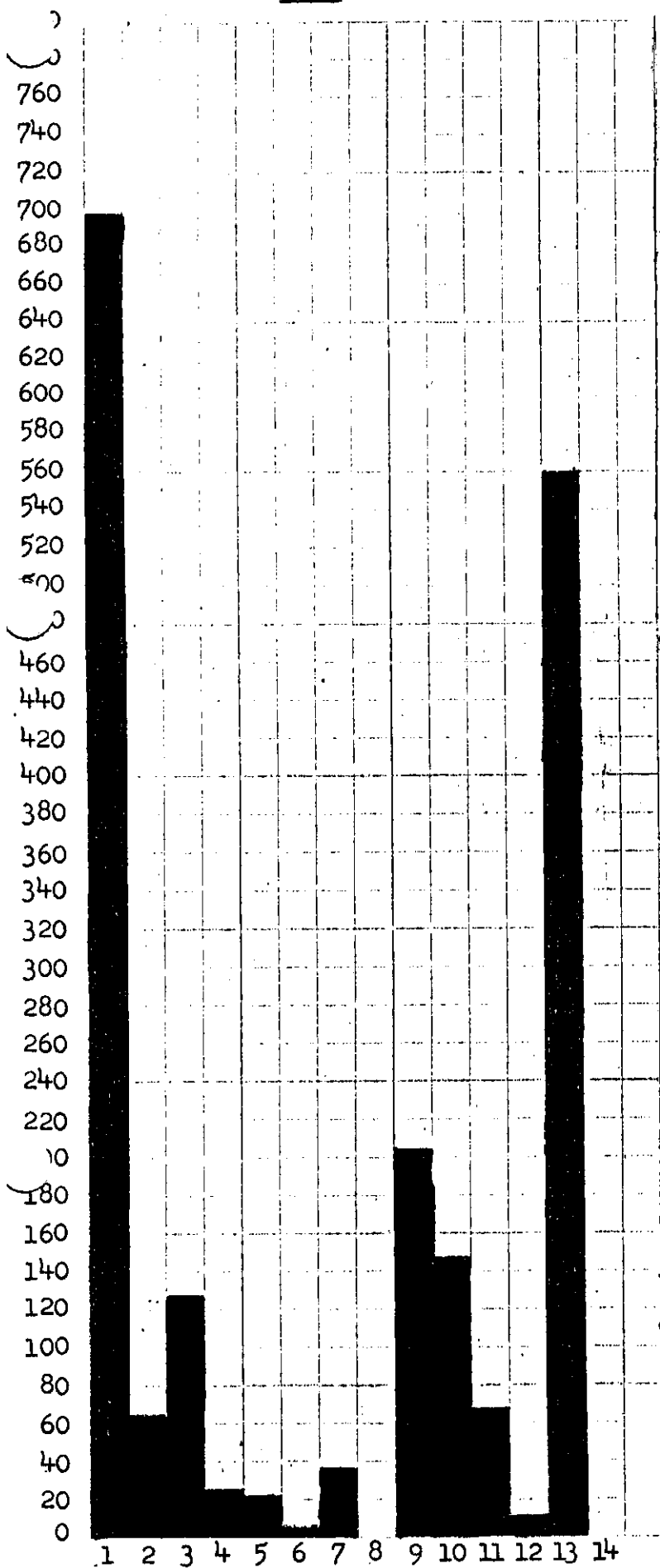

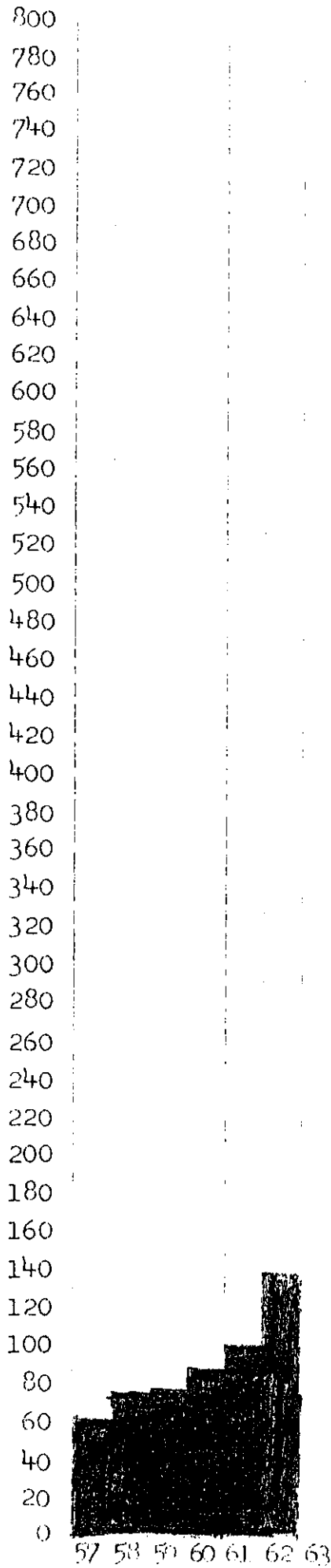
TOTAL FISH LANDINGS (ALL SPECIES) TAKEN FROM THE CONVENTION AREA

BY COUNTRY AND YEAR

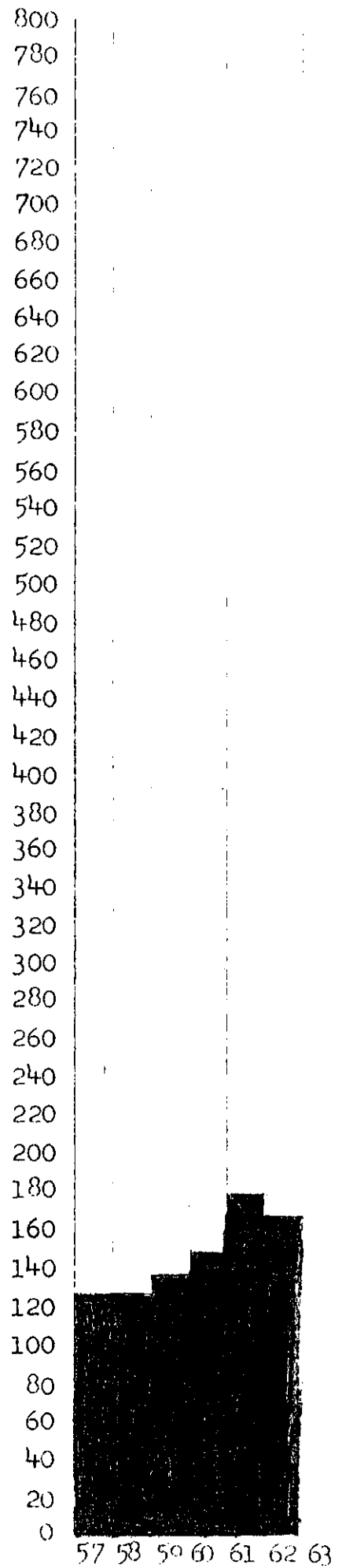

BY COUNTRY AND YEAR

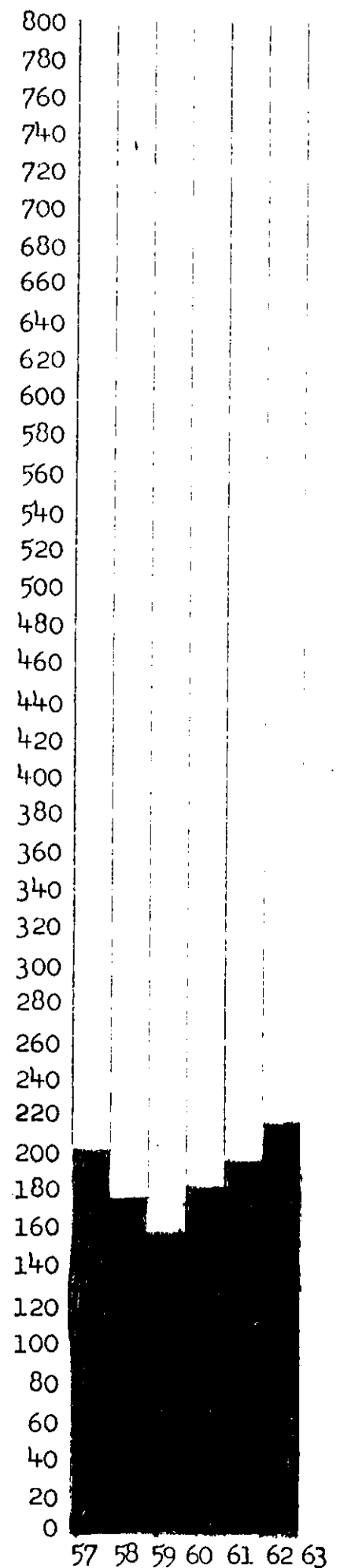

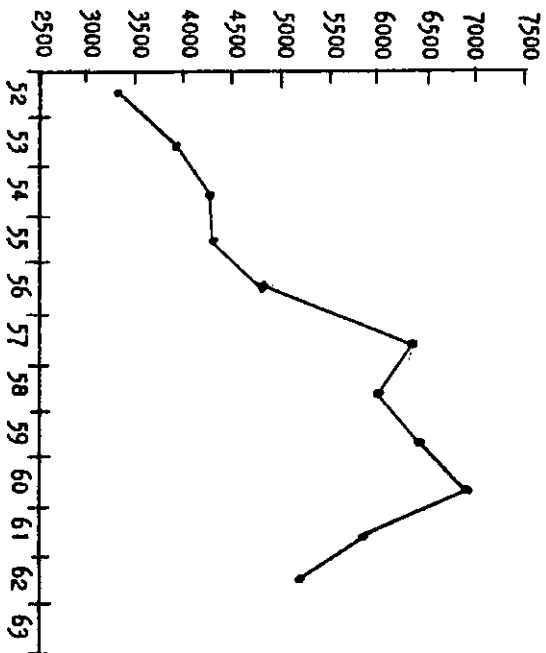
HADDOCK LANDINGS

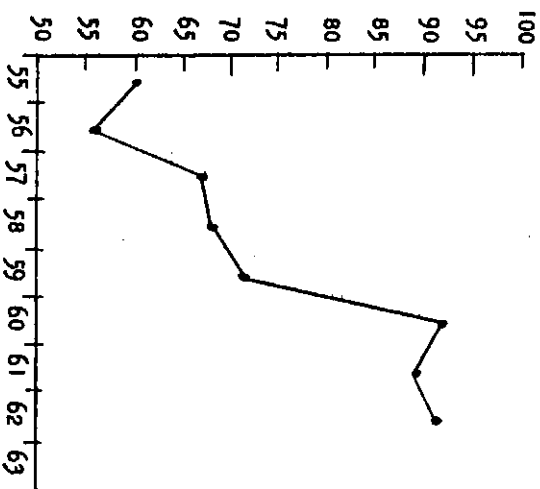
RED FISH LANDINGS

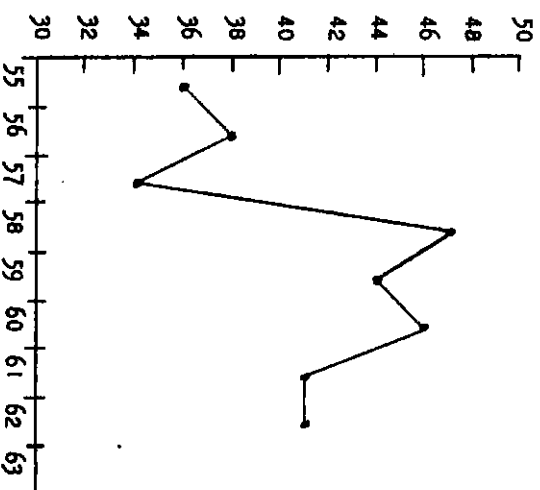
HALIBUT LANDINGS

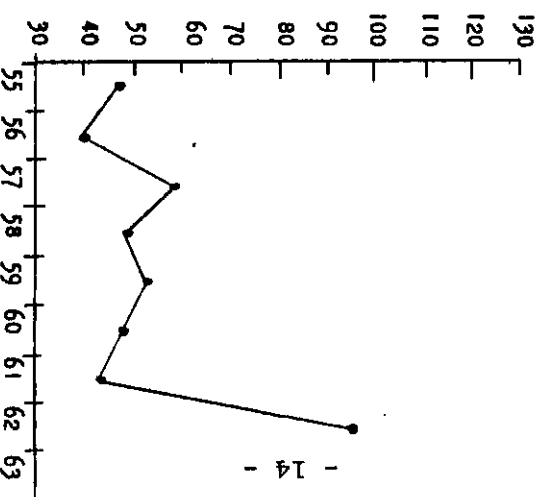
FLOUNDER LANDINGS

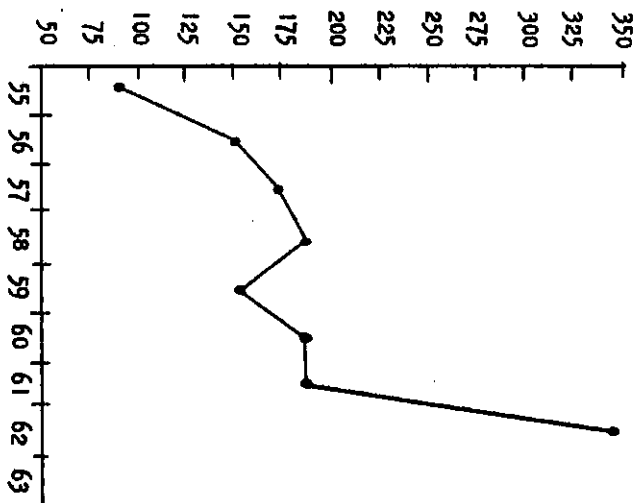
POLLOCK LANDINGS

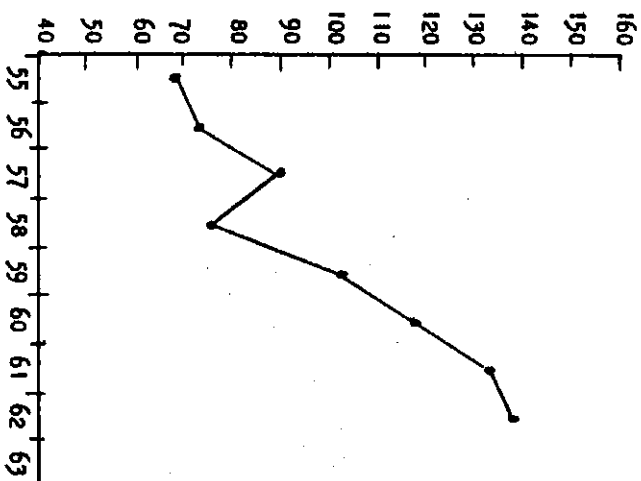
SILVER HAKE
