Report on Annual Returns of Infringements to ICNAF Trawl Regulations

by the Secretariat
(25 May 1965)

1. Improvements to the form "Annual Returns of Infringements" (ICNAF Trawl Regulations/19.10.64) were suggested by the ad hoc Committee on Trawl Regulations (1964 Meeting Proceedings No. 15, Appendix II, para. 3) and adopted by the Commission (1964 Meeting Proceedings No. 19, para. 5).
2. The revised form was circulated from the Secretariat 22 October 1964 for completion by member countries to cover their inspections, infringements, warnings and prosecutions for the calendar year 1964.
3. To date returns have been received from Canada (Newfoundland), Canada (Maritimes), Canada (Quebec), Fed. Rep. Germany, Iceland, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Spain, USSR, UK and USA. Original returns will be tabled at the Annual Meeting.
4. For ready reference, Appendix I summarizes infringements to the trawl regulations having to do with mesh size; Appendix II summarizes infringements having to do with mesh obstruction and Appendix III summarizes infringements to regulations regarding excess landings.
