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Report on Conference on Electronic Engineering in Oceanography: ______Southampton, England: 12-15 September, 1966

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The Conference on Electronic Engineering in Oceanography was organized by the Institution of Electronic and Radio Engineers, London and held at Southampton University on 12-15 September 1966. About 230 people from 15 countries attended. The conference was the first of its kind to be held in Europe in that it brought together marine scientists and firms engaged in electronic engineering. It was organized in four sessions dealing respectively with (a) the measurement of the physical and chemical properties of the sea (b) the fishery applications of electronic engineering (c) measurements concerned with the sea surface and the sea bed (d) research vessels, buoys, submerged vehicles, telemetry, data handling and navigation. In all some 50 papers were presented. Most of these have been published in full in:-
