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Statistics on catch (1960-66) tagging (1966) and capture (1960-66)<br>of Atlantic salmon in Eire

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The attached statistics include all the available data from 1960 to 1966. Tables 1 to 4 give some idea of the fluctuations in salmon and grilse catches since 1960. All fish captured up to the end of May are classed as salmon whereas fish captured from June onward are classed as grilse. This, it is considered, is a correct assumption from the scale reading results avallable from a representative number of rivers throughout the country The only data avallable in catch-per-unit effort is the total catch in avoirdupois together with the number of fishing engines engaged. This gives a rather dubious figure for catch-per-unit effort and may not be acceptable,

The only tagging data available (Table 5) are for 2,971 kelts and 41 clean fish tagged in 1966 and a sample of 15.000 hatchery reared smolts tagged on the Shannon River. The tag used for smolt tagging was not considered to be very satisfactory and it may be as well to discount these results. The smolts were released as one-year olds in March 1966. There will be no results from these taggings until June or July 1967, since the River Shannon is, on the main, a grilse river.

The only available data on capture of salmon at sea (Table 6) is from what is termed "open sea" drift nets. These nets capture salmon up to a maximum distance of seven miles from the coast
