Annual Returns of Infringements, 1968  
By the ICNAF Secretariat

Returns /to 29 May 1969/ relating to mesh size, mesh obstructions and excess landing for 1968 were received from all Contracting Governments except Denmark, France, Germany /Fed. Rep./, Iceland and Norway. UK had no returns. Italy did not fish in the ICNAF Convention Area in 1968.

This document presents a summary of inspections, infringements and actions taken by Contracting Governments as a result of their efforts to ensure adherence by their nationals to the Commission's trawl regulations.
