- The Acting Secretary of State presents his compliments to Their Excellencies and Messieurs the Chiefs of Mission of the Governments concerned with the International Convention for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries signed at Washington under date of February 8, 1949 and has the honor to transmit the following information.
- received notification on December 11, 1969 of the acceptance by the Government of Norway of proposal (1), adopted by the International Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries on June 6, 1969. The Government of the United States also received notification on December 16, 1969 of the acceptance by the Government of Portugal of proposals (2), (3), and (4), adopted by the Commission on June 7, 1969. On December 30, 1969 the notification of acceptance of all four of these proposals on behalf of the Government of the United States of America, signed on September 12, 1969, was deposited with the Department of State.
- Instruments of ratification of the Protocol to the International Convention for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Relating to Measures of Control, signed at Washington under date of November 29, 1965, and the Protocol to the International Convention for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries

Relating to Entry into Force of Proposals Adopted by the Commission, signed at Washington under date of November 29, 1965, have been deposited with the Government of the United States of America by the Government of Italy and the Government of Portugal on December 19, 1969. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article III of the Protocol Relating to Measures of Control and of paragraph 2 of Article II of the Protocol Relating to Entry into Force, the two Protocols entered into force on December 19, 1969 for all Governments parties to the Convention. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article III of the Protocol Relating to Measures of Control, Article II of that Protocol will not enter into force.

The Government of the United States observes that the provisions of paragraphs 7 and 8 of Article VIII of the International Convention for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries were amended effective December 19, 1969 by the Protocol Relating to Entry into Force of Proposals Adopted by the Commission, that the new provisions of those paragraphs, and the Protocol itself do not contain any transitory provisions regarding proposals of the Commission which were outstanding at the time the new provisions became effective, and that there were nine such proposals outstanding at the time of entry into force of the Protocol, five adopted by the International Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries on June 9, 1967 and four adopted by the International Commission for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries on June 6 and 7, 1969. In the circumstances, and recalling the terms of paragraph 6 of Article VIII of the Convention,

which provides that the Depositary Government "may make such suggestions as will facilitate acceptance of" proposals made by the Commission, the Government of the United States suggests that the proposals of the Commission become effective in accordance with the following.

- on June 7, 1969 include regulations designed to become effective on January 1, 1970. These proposals have been accepted under the former provisions of the Convention by a majority of the respective Panel members, and it is understood that the remainder of the acceptances will be deposited in the very near future; they were adopted unanimously by the Commission, and no objections were filed within the six months specified in the Protocol.

 Accordingly, it is considered that the Contracting Governments intended that the regulations become effective on January 1, 1970, as proposed, and the Depositary Government will consider that to be the effective date unless any Contracting Government notifies it of objection to this procedure.
- on June 9, 1967, each of the five proposals have been accepted under the former provisions of the Convention by a majority of the respective Panel members; they were adopted unanimously by the Commission, and no objections have been filed to date, which period is far in excess of the six months provided for objections under the terms of the Protocol. Accordingly, the Depositary Government

concludes that the Contracting Governments intend to bring these proposals into force, and under the terms of the Protocol shall consider that no objections have been filed within the specified period for objecting. For the convenience of the Contracting Governments in implementing the proposals, the Depositary Government will consider these five proposals to be effective on the same date as the three aforementioned proposals, January 1, 1970, unless any Contracting Government notifies it of objection to this procedure.

Proposal (1) adopted by the Commission on June 6, 1969 has been accepted by a majority of Contracting Governments under the former provisions of the Convention, it was adopted by a two-thirds majority in the Commission, and has been objected to by two Contracting Governments. Under the provisions of the Protocol with respect to such objections, entry into force of the proposal is automatically delayed for sixty days during which additional objections may be made, or within thirty days of receiving notice of an objection made within such sixty days. the convenience of the Contracting Governments, the Depositary Government will consider the additional period or periods for objecting to run from the same date as the entry into force of the aforementioned proposals, January 1, 1970, unless any Contracting Government notifies it of objection to this procedure. In the circumstances, and considering the provisions of the Protocol, objections to the proposal may be filed by any Contracting Government,

regardless of whether it has accepted the proposal or taken no action on it under the former terms of the Convention. The two objections received shall be considered to remain as objections, unless withdrawn under the terms of the Protocol. The Department of State will promptly notify all Contracting Governments of objections received, or of the entry into force of the proposal.

- The Acting Secretary of State regrets that the close juxtaposition of the entry into force of the Protocols, the conclusion of the six month period specified in the Protocol Relating to Entry into Force of Proposals, and the proposed entry into force date of the regulations referred to above precluded earlier notice on these matters.
- 9. The Acting Secretary of State would be grateful if each Chief of Mission would forward this information to his Government.
