ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE 1971

Report of the Third Meeting of the
ICES/ICNAF/IOC Coordinating Group for the North Atlantic
"Folkets Rus", Copenhagen, Thursday, 1 October 1970, at 13:00

The following persons participated in the meeting:

1. The Group reviewed the report of its last meeting (Dublin, 1969) and noted with satisfaction that the interchange of information between the three Secretariats is effective and smooth.

It was further noted that the three resolutions on Ocean Weather Station Data and Inventories for Ocean Weather Stations A, J, K, and M were now being processed and published by ICES, that one volume was ready just before the present Statutory Meeting, and that another was ready for distribution.

The data were now being analyzed by the Council's Hydrographer for publication in the Council's new series "ICES Oceanographic Data Lists and Inventories", which will replace the "ICES Oceanographic Data Lists".

2. It was noted with reference to the IOC Res. VI-11, that the plans for a new "Overflow" expedition were being developed.
3. It had appeared that in the coming years there would be a need within the ICES and ICNAF machineries to review annually the progress of IGOSS and the feeding of fisheries requirements into it.

As far as ICES was concerned, it was recommended that the Chairman of the relevant Area- and Subject-Committees, or their representatives, should meet during the Statutory Meetings together with the IOC Observer(s) for these purposes.

The ICNAF representatives agreed to take this need into account in collaboration with the Chairman of the ICNAF Environmental Subcommittee, when planning the ICNAF Annual Meetings.

4. There was no other business, and the meeting was closed at 1400 hours.
