ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE 1971

DRAFT PROSPECTUS: CWP MEETINGS, NOVEMBER 1971, ROME

(Coordinating Working Party on Atlantic Fisheries Statistics)

1. General

- 1.1 The Seventh Session of the CWP is scheduled to take place in Rome over a period of 7-8 days during the first half of November. It is to be preceded by a two-day meeting of an ad hoc CWP Working Group on Automatic Data Processing.
- 1.2 The dates selected fit in with meetings of (a) ICCAT Subcommittees beginning their meetings in Madrid on Thursday (18 November 1971) and (b) ICCAT's Standing Committee on Research and Statistics beginning, also in Madrid, on Thursday, 25 November 1971.

FAO's biennial Conference (the Sixteenth Session) takes place in Rome, at FAO Headquarters, 6-25 November 1971.

2. Dates of the CWP meetings

- 2.1 The ad hoc CWP Working Group on Automatic Data Processing is to meet on Monday and Tuesday (8 and 9 November 1971). The first meeting will start at 10.00 on Monday.
- 2.2 The first meeting of the <u>Seventh Session of the CWP</u> will start at 10.00, Wednesday (10 November 1971). It is expected that the last meeting will close late on Tuesday afternoon (16 November 1971).

3. Place

It is expected that both the Working Group on ADP and the CWP will meet in Rome. Italy. The meetings will be accommodated in FAO's Building "F", located in Via Cristoforo Colombo (No. 426) about 4 km from FAO Headquarters.
