SEVENTH SPECIAL COMMISSION MEETING - SEPTEMBER 1975

Memorandum by the United States concerning keeping of logbooks - Subarea 5 and Statistical Area 6

Following the practice initiated by the United States at the Fifth Special Meeting of ICNAF (November 1974), the attached material summarizes the results of inspections of fishing logbooks undertaken by US officials during the course of fishing vessel inspection under the Scheme of Joint Enforcement. During the period 1 January through 31 August 1975, a total of 368 fishing and fishing support vessels were boarded to perform inspections under the Scheme of Joint Enforcement. Of this total, 236 boardings resulted in detailed examination of logbooks. These data are set forth in the following Tables:
