ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE 1979

Report on Inspections under the Scheme of Joint International Enforcement in 1979

Captain responded that he did not have conversion factor, therefore, recorded weight given him by the production chief. 2. Inspector estimated 66 MT salt fish on <u>SEGUNDO</u> . Captain stated other fish was caught outside ICNAF waters between Apr. 17-24. This was not recorded in the logbook.
