RESOLUTIONS

- C.Res.1978/1:2 The selected contributions to the ICES/ICNAF Symposium on the Biological Basis of Pelagic Fish Stock Management, which was held at Aberdeen in July 1978, should be published in the *Rapports et Procès-Verbaux* series, with Mr A. Saville as Editor.
- C.Res.1978/1:4 The offer by ICNAF to print selected papers and proceedings from the Symposium on the Early Life History of Fish, as a volume in the *Rapports et Procès-Verbaux* series, with Mr K. Sherman and Mr R. Lasker as Editors, be accepted with appreciation.
- C.Res.1978/2:1 In view of the rapid developments in the application of acoustic techniques in estimating fish abundance and of their importance in fisheries science, an international Symposium on Fisheries Acoustics should be organized in the near future, preferably during 1981, with possible support from other organizations, including FAO. Emphasis should be on stock assessment and general technical developments.
- C.Res.1978/2:2 Plans should be developed for a Symposium, to be convened possibly in 1981, on primary, secondary and fish production in selected shelf areas in the North Atlantic, including Georges Bank-Gulf of Maine, Iceland, the North Sea, and the Baltic Sea.
