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This should be regarded as a supplementary information to the stock size and allowable yield estimates presented in NAFO Scr.Doc. 80/II/46. The stock size assessment for 1981 was made from the stock size and allowable yield estimates for 1980. In 1980, the total silver hake quota for Subarea 4 was 100 thous. tons, however, since quotas were not taken year after year, the possible yield totalled to 51.5 thous. tons. The USSR catch constituted 44.9 thous. tons. Quota allocations for the USSR were 45 and 56.6 thous. tons in 1979 and 1980 respectively. Therefore, as in the previous years, the total silver hake catch in 1980 will hardly exceed the USSR quota significantly, and is expected to be around 60-65 thous. tons.

In table 1 the stock size estimate of 929 thous. tons is given for 1981, which may provide the allowable yield of 187 thous. tons if the fishing mortality rate the same as in 1979 persists in 1981.
