Extracts from Resolutions Passed at the 69th Statutory Meeting of ICES, October 1981

RESOLUTIONS

- C.Res.1981/1:1 (a) The Council will publish a series of "Fiches d'Identification des Maladies et Parasites des Poissons, Crustacés et Mollusques" in accordance with a plan proposed by the Working Group on Pathology and Diseases of Marine Organisms, but bilingual (English/French) text.
- (b) Dr. C. J. Sindermann should be Editor of the series for the next three years.
- (c) Ten sheets in the new series shall be published in the financial year 1981/82.
- C.Res.1981/2:12 The Statistics Committee Liaison Working Group should meet 10-11 June 1982 at ICES Headquarters to consider the Agenda for the CWP Meeting in July 1982 and to review the current status of the STATLANT Programme. Further, the Group should draw up a proposal for publishing aquaculture statistics in Bulletin Statistique for consideration at the 1982 Council Meeting.
- C.Res.1981/3:1 (a) The ICES Statistician and the Chairman of the Statistics Committee should participate in the 11th Session of the Coordinating Working Party on Atlantic Fishery Statistics (CWP) during 21-28 July 1982 in Luxembourg.
- (b) The USSR be nominated as the ICES member country to participate in the 11th and 12th Sessions of the CWP at national expense.
- C.Res.1981/5:1 Special themes for certain Committees at the Statutory Meeting in 1982.
- Fish Capture Committee. Energy consideration in fish locomotion and in fish capture processes.
- Hydrography Committee. Shelf edge and slope processes.
- Statistics Committee. Precision estimate applied to stock assessments and TACs.
- Marine Environmental Quality and Biological Oceanography Committees. Plankton blooms, their causes and effects on the fisheries and ecosystems.
- Demersal Fish Committee. The use of fishing effort data in assessment and management.
- Pelagic Fish Committee. How to take into account the variability of recruitment in fish stock assessment and management.
