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Provisional Sealing Statistics for the Northwest Atlantic, 1982

Reports on sealing catch and effort in the Northwest Atlantic for 1982 have been received from Canada for the "Front" and "Gulf" areas and Norway for the "Front" area. No reports are yet available for Danish seal catches in Subarea 1 and Canadian seal catches in Subarea 0.

All available data on catches of harp and hooded seals for the calendar year 1982 are listed in Table 1, and corresponding statistics on hunting effort are given in Table 2. Norwegian statistics for harp seals do not distinguish between "bedlamer" and "old harp".

Bedlamer - I year or older with spotted pelt, roughly equivalent to immature animals Old harp - animals with conspicuous saddle mark on back and sides, roughly equivalent

to mature animals

Explanation of Effort Terms

Engine HP - brake horsepower

Landsmen - shore fishermen, including those using small vessels or aircraft

No. of men
Days absent - number of days absent from port including the day the vessel sails but

not the day of landing
