## Provisional Sealing Statistics for the Northwest Atlantic, 1983

Reports on sealing catch and effort in the Northwest Atlantic for 1983 have been received from Canada for the "Front" and "Gulf" areas. Norwegian vessels did not participate in the Northwest Atlantic seal hunt in 1983. No reports are yet available for Danish seal catches in Subarea 1 and Canadian seal catches in Subarea 0.

All available data on catches of harp and hooded seals for the calendar year 1983 are listed in Table 1, and corresponding statistics on hunting effort are given in Table 2.

## Definition of Seal Age Categories

Whitecoat

- less than 2 weeks old with unmoulted white fur (lanugo).

Beater

- more than 2 weeks old.

Bedlamer

- 1 year or older with spotted pelt, roughly equivalent to immature animals.

01d harp

- animals with conspicuous saddle mark on back and sides, roughly equivalent

to mature animals.

## Explanation of Effort Terms

Engine HP

- brake horsepower

Landsmen No. of men - shore fishermen, including those using small vessels or aircraft.

Days absent

total number in crew if "vessel" and number of hunters if "landsmen".
number of days absent from port including the day the vessel sails but not

the day of landing.

NOTE: The numbers inadvertently listed under "white-coat" in Table 1 of the initial version of this document were "tanners" and "ragged jackets" which were more than 2 weeks old. These are now included under "beaters", in accordance with the definitation of seal age categories.
