An Update on the Status of the Cod Stock in Division 3M

Nominal catch

The nominal catches for this stock have been about 10,000 t since 1980 when TAC's were considerably higher. Large portions of the catches since that time have been taken by vessels from: Spain, Faroe Islands, Norway, Portugal, and USSR. The nominal catch for 1985, given in Table 1 by country and month as obtained from NAFO circular letters, has been about the same as the recent average.

The commercial fishery

As in the past, only limited sampling information was available for the calculation of catch at age. These included 164 ages and 4212 length measurements from Portuguese based vessels and 38 ages and 2171 length measurements from Faroese based vessels. The 1985 catch and average weight at age are presented in Table 2. Again, only the 1980 and 1981 year-classes, which comprised about 90% in numbers, appeared to be of any consequence in the 1985 catch.

Research vessel surveys

Research vessel surveys have been conducted on the Flemish Cap by the GADUS ATLANTICA for the period 1978-85 and a survey of limited coverage was conducted in 1977 by the A. T. CAMERON. There was no Canadian survey in 1986. The results from these surveys were presented last year (Wells and Baird, 1985) and are not given here. At the time of last years meeting only a sample of the research ages collected during the 1985 survey had been read.

Table 3 gives the average catch per tow at age for all fish aged from the 1985 survey. As in the commercial catch, the dominant year-class in the survey was that of 1981, with the 1982 year-class showing some promise.
