LIST OF SCIENTISTS AND LABORATORIES  
ENGAGED IN THE VARIOUS BRANCHES OF THE COMMISSION'S WORK.

In the Fishery Research Program for the Northwest Atlantic Area prepared by the Special Committee on Commission's Research Program and adopted by the Commission at the Annual Meeting 1953 it is stated that co-ordination of research work shall be achieved i.a. by

"the maintenance, through the Executive Secretary, of an up-to-date list of scientists engaged in the various branches of Commission's work".

According to that same program Commission's work is mainly concerned with the following species: cod, haddock, redfish and halibut, further with hydrography and statistics.

When preparing the first tentative list (circulated in December 1953) it was found adequate to consider mainly scientists working with the above stated subjects, and from the ten participating countries (this limitation is the more justified as ICES is publishing corresponding lists for countries being members of ICES, thus covering the countries working in the Atlantic without being members of ICNAF).

It has been found of value to give also a list of laboratories from which work is being carried out in the Convention Area.

It would be appreciated if any amendments could be forwarded to the Secretariat during this Annual Meeting.
