

ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE 1955Lists of Fishing Vessels Operating in the Convention Area

The Commission approved, at its Fourth Annual Meeting, June, 1954, the following two recommendations:

- a. That the countries be asked to supply every three years a list of their vessels fishing in the Convention Area to keep the Commission records up to date and to furnish a basis for reviewing the classification of vessels used in submitting statistics;
- b. That the following classification of fishing vessels be used in submitting statistical reports:
 Otter Trawlers, Long Liners and Dory Schooners
 Group 1: 50 gross tons and under
 Group 2: 51-150 gross tons
 Group 3: 151-500 gross tons
 Group 4: 501-900 gross tons
 Group 5: Over 900 gross tons.

In accordance with these recommendations, the attached lists including the information forwarded to the Secretariat pertaining to this subject have been prepared.

The lists include data from 1952 (Denmark (Greenland), U.S.A.), from 1953 (Canada, Denmark (Greenland), Italy, Norway, Spain, U.K.), from 1954 (Denmark (Faroes), France, Iceland, Portugal).

Under the heading "date" in the lists is entered the year in which the vessel in question began operations in the Convention Area (in such cases this will mean the year of construction).

A short compilation of the data in these lists is given in an appendix.

Last year it was proposed that all vessels be classified, according to size, into the following groups: -

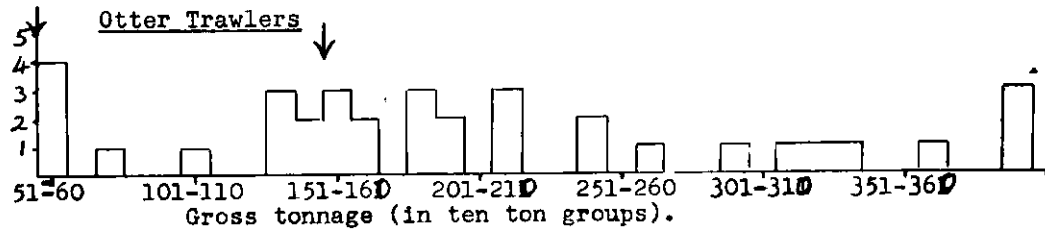

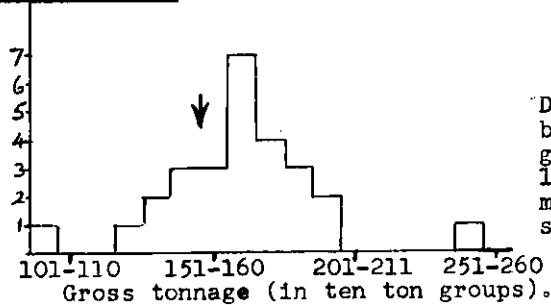
Canada (Maritimes & Quebec) 1953.

In addition to the vessels shown here there is a large fleet of vessels of less than 50 gross tons.



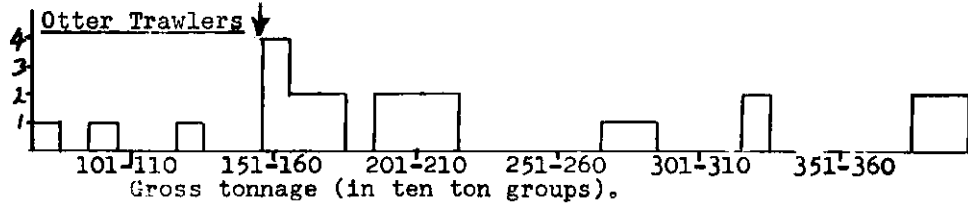

Dory Schooners



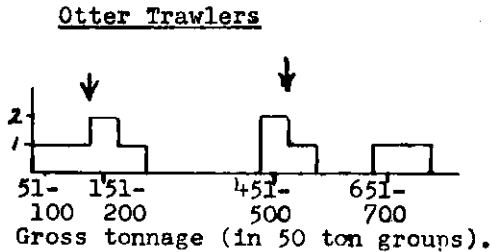
Dory schooners appear to be a homogeneous effort group. The two vessels lying rather far from the mean might be considered separately.

Canada (Newfoundland) 1953.

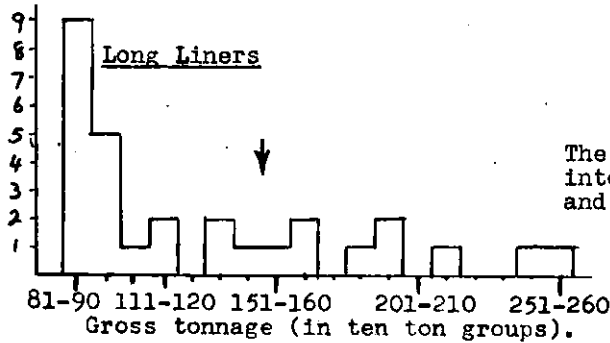


The 14 vessels 151-250 gross tons, are probably the best effort group here. The 251-500 gross tons group (8 vessels) could be a second effort group.

Denmark (Faroes) 1954.

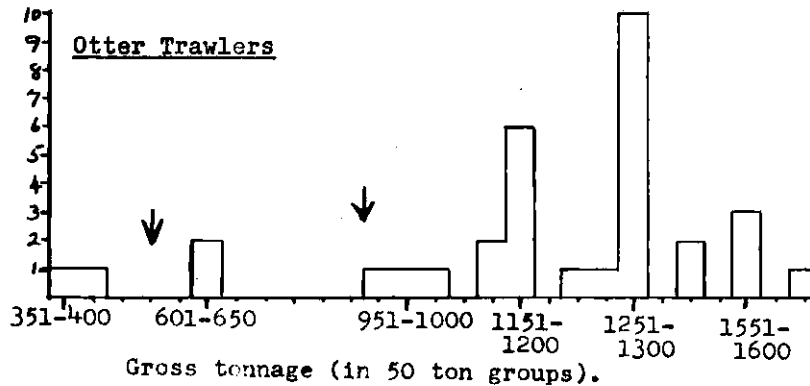


The otter trawlers might best be divided into two effort groups at about 300 gross tons.



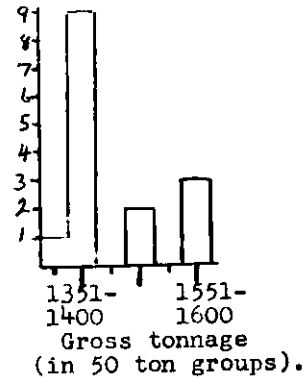
The long liners could be divided into effort groups at about 125 and 175 gross tons.

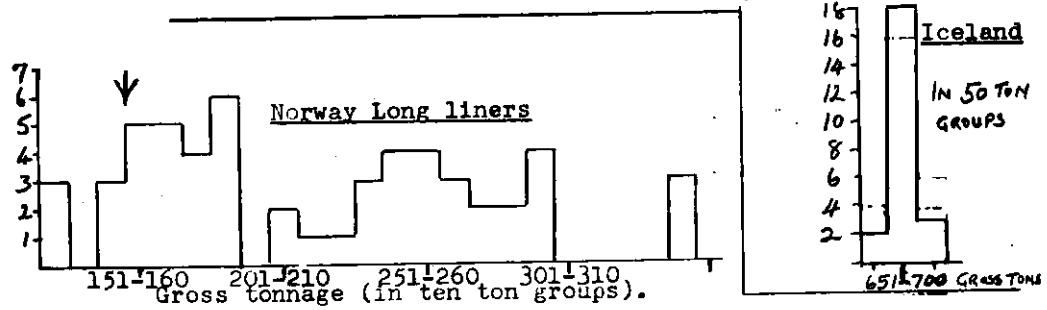

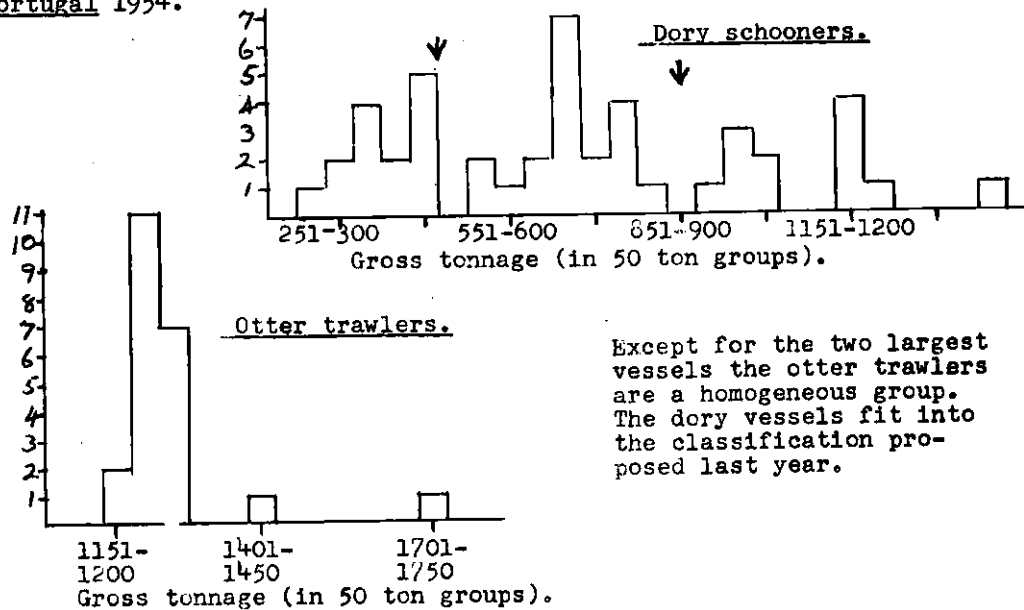
Iceland 1954.

Otter Trawlers The Icelandic otter trawlers form a very homogenous group.



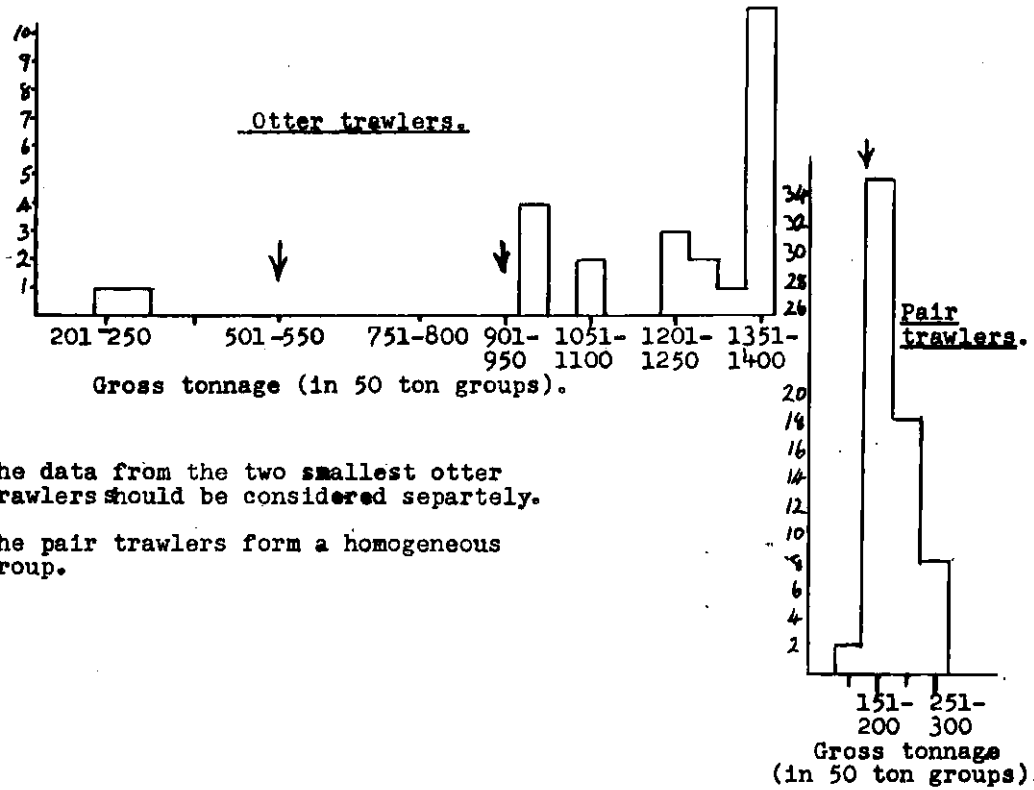
Norway 1953. - Long Liners . This fleet could be divided into three effort groups: - 101-200; 201-300; 301-350 gross tons.

Spain 1953.



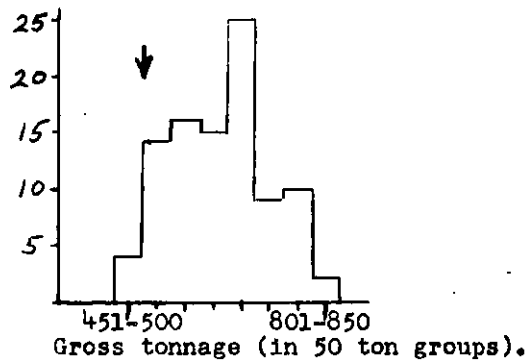
The data from the two smallest otter trawlers should be considered separately.
