# ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE 1959

## List of Papers Pertaining to the Northwest Atlantic

Item 4 of the Report of the Ad hoc Subcommittee on Publications, App. XII to the Report of the Standing Committee on Research and Statistics, Annual Meeting, 1958, reads:

"ICNAF should make use of the FAO bibliographic service. The Secretariat should select out from the FAO bibliography a list of papers pertaining to the Northwest Atlantic, adding other papers which may not have been included. This list should be prepared as a document for the 1959 meeting when it can be reviewed and considered for publication in the Proceedings."

Following this request the attached list of papers has been prepared by the Secretariat.

As a list of this kind obviously will have to be prepared annually - if the Commission should decide to have it prepared - I have restricted the present list to include only papers which have been published in the calender year 1958.

In preparing the list the FAO "Current Bibliography for Fisheries Science" nos. 1-10 have been consulted, and use has been made of papers forwarded to the Secretariat by the member countries.

The great problem in preparing a list of this kind is of course what papers to be included under the term "pertaining to the Northwest Atlantic". The <u>ad hoc</u> subcommittee has not in its report made any attempt of a definition. If further such lists are to be prepared it is suggested that a closer definition of the said term is agreed to.

In preparing the list I have considered as "pertinent":

- Papers delaing with investigations in the Convention Area on food fishes or food invertebrates with which ICNAF is concerned or may naturally be concerned.
- Papers dealing with environmental studies (hydrography, plankton, bottom invertebrates) in the Convention Area.
- 3. Papers similar to those of items 1 and 2 but concerning investigations carried out outside the Convention Area, provided their methods or results can be applied to the ICNAF area.
- 4. Papers on technical problems related to the fisheries of the Convention Area.
  - a. on fisheries statistics (monthly or annual papers merely with statistical data not included).
  - b. on mesh and other gear studies.
  - c. on fisheries techniques.d. on treatment of fish after capture.

It is without doubt that a choice of papers to be made based on the above definitions must to a high degree be subjected to a personal, and even a "temporal" bias.

The following list can in no way be considered complete on account partly of the above-mentioned bias and partly of the fact that a number of papers - mainly from the latter part of 1958 may have escaped notice.

The papers in the attached list are arranged by countries in order to facilitate the revision of the list by the scientists from the various countries. A final list will of course have to be arranged according to subjects. It is suggested that the subcommittee to revise the list consider the basis for an arrangement by subjects.

A number of the titles in the attached list are only given in an abbreviated form.
