ICNAF MESH REGULATION OPERATION OF 10% ANNUAL EXEMPTION

October 1, 1957, through March 31, 1959

The United States Bureau of Commercial Fisheries, Fish and Wildlife Service, issued 23 exemption certificates during the first year, and 16 additional certificates during the first six months of the second year to U.S. vessels. These certificates were issued by month and year as follows:
