



COMPARATIVE SUMMARY OF DATA FROM STATISTICS FORM 3

(Statistics On Fishing Effort)

FOR THE YEARS 1961 AND 1962

At the 1963 Annual Meeting the Subcommittee on Statistics recommended that during the coming year the Secretariat, in consultation with a representative of the Statistics Subcommittee, prepare a format suitable for publication of these Form 3 data in the Statistical Bulletin, and summarize data for a recent period of two or three years in the suggested format with summaries to be circulated to countries during the coming year. It should be decided at the 1964 Annual Meeting if the summary does provide valuable information of ICNAF fishing activity, and if so, consider where and how best to publish it. There was general agreement that if data were not to be published, the completion of Statistical Form 3 should no longer be requested.

The Commission's Statistician in meeting with the Chairman of the Statistics Subcommittee agreed upon a format in which these data would be summarized by countries for each gear with its respective effort data for each subarea. Totals are to be shown where possible. The information column would provide for the following three captions:

No. of Vessels
No. of Trips
Days Absent

It was agreed that "Average Gross Tonnage" should not be included as information.

The years selected were 1961 and 1962 since these were the most nearly complete for comparative purposes. Prior to the year 1961 a great many of the member countries failed to submit the Statistics Form 3 with their annual statistics. The returns from member countries for the years 1961 and 1962 numbered 10 and 11 respectively.

It may be in order at this point to indicate certain of those items which warrant some thought before a summary of this nature could be put to a profitable use.

(1) Vessel Category

- (a) Some vessels may be used for more than one type of fishing by merely changing the gear to be used. Are these vessels included only under that vessel category in which its major operation has been performed or have they been included under several vessel categories depending on main species sought?

NOTE: (i) Under Otter Trawlers (151-500 tons) for U. S. S. R., it has been indicated by a footnote that these vessels have been used for groundfish catch by trawls and herring catch by drift nets.

(ii) Under Long Liners for Canada (M & Q), it has been definitely shown by main species sought that effort may be directed towards cod, haddock, halibut or swordfish.

(iii) Under Long Liners for Norway, it has been separated according to direction of main species sought, such as, "cod" or "halibut and porbeagle".

(1) Vessel Category (Cont'd)

(b) Should there be a special category for "Factory Trawlers" or are these to be reported under "Otter Trawlers"?

(2) Tonnage Class

(a) The tonnage class "0-50" has been reported as follows: 0-25, 26-50 and 0-50.

(b) In one instance the tonnage class "151-500" included vessels of the 575 tonnage class. (A footnote has been used in this instance.)

(c) In one instance one vessel of the "over 1800 ton class" has been included with the 901-1800 tonnage class.

(d) Nets, traps and seines are shown as 0-50 tons. This refers to the size of vessel used to service that type of gear and does not in any way refer to the tonnage capacity of the trap, etc.

(3) Country

There has been considerable improvement in the number of countries that have been reporting their effort data on the Statistics 3 Form during the years 1961 and 1962.

(4) No. of Vessels

(a) In some instances the total number of vessels fishing in the convention area is not reported. This figure cannot be obtained by adding together the vessels that have fished in each subarea.

(b) In some instances, "totals" for the Convention Area are given but there is nothing reported for the respective subareas.

(c) One member country has counted into its "No. of vessels" the actual number of times that each vessel has returned to the same subarea.

(5) No. of Trips

(a) Where vessels have fished in a subarea for less than a half trip it has been tabulated as a full trip.

(b) Some member countries, who reported in tenths of trips in their Statistics 1 Form, failed to indicate this procedure in their Statistics 3 Form. It was, therefore, assumed that these trips referred to tenths of trips since otherwise these effort data would in some instances be greatly out of proportion to that of "Days Absent".

(c) In some instances the "No. of Trips" is questionably less than the "No. of Vessels". This could be due to the fact that these vessels fished only a part of a trip in one subarea on a great many occasions.

(6) Days Absent

On a great many occasions "Total Days Absent" have not been shown since not all countries have reported "Days Absent" in full for all subareas.

(7) Totals

In the majority of cases it has been impossible to give "totals" since not all countries have given all the "information" requested.

"THAT THE PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTS BE REQUESTED TO REPORT IN SUMMARY FORM INFORMATION ON THE NUMBER OF VESSELS OF VARIOUS TYPES AND SIZES FISHING IN THE CONVENTION AREA DURING EACH YEAR."

1953 (3RD ANNUAL MEETING)

"THE SUBCOMMITTEE NOTED THE USEFULNESS OF "SUMMARY STATISTICS FORM 3" FOR INTERPRETATION OF ICNAF STATISTICS. THOSE COUNTRIES NOT REPORTING ON THIS FORM ARE URGED TO DO SO."

1962 (12TH ANNUAL MEETING)

1. THIS FORM IS TO PROVIDE THE DATA REQUESTED IN THE RECOMMENDATIONS QUOTED ABOVE AND AT THE SAME TIME TO PROVIDE DATA ON NUMBER OF TRIPS AND DAYS ABSENT.
2. THE CLASSIFICATION OF VESSELS SHOULD CORRESPOND EXACTLY TO THE CLASSIFICATION USED IN REPORTING THE DETAILED STATISTICS IN FORM 1.
3. BECAUSE THE SAME VESSEL MAY FISH IN MORE THAN ONE SUBAREA, THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VESSELS FISHING IN THE CONVENTION AREA WILL NOT NECESSARILY BE THE TOTAL OF THE NUMBER OF VESSELS FISHING IN EACH SEPARATE SUBAREA. WHEN A TRIP IS SPENT PARTLY IN ONE SUBAREA AND PARTLY IN ANOTHER, AN APPROPRIATE FRACTION SHOULD BE ALLOCATED TO EACH SUBAREA, IN PROPORTION TO THE DAYS FISHED IN EACH SUBAREA, TO THE EFFECT THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TRIPS AND OF DAYS ABSENT FOR THE CONVENTION AREA WILL BE THE TOTAL OF THE NUMBERS IN EACH SEPARATE SUBAREA.
4. "AVERAGE GROSS TONNAGE" REPRESENTS GROSS REGISTERED TONS; AVERAGES SHOULD BE GIVEN EITHER AS STRAIGHT (UNWEIGHTED) AVERAGES OR AS WEIGHTED AVERAGES, WITH COUNTRIES SPECIFYING WHICH MEASURE HAS BEEN TAKEN (THE WEIGHTING OF AVERAGES IS TO BE PERFORMED ON THE BASIS OF "NUMBER OF TRIPS").
