# ANNUAL MEETING - JUNE 1967

### Canadian Government salary revisions affecting ICNAF

At its 1965 Annual Meeting, the Commission authorized the establishment of Canadian Government salary classifications for employees of the Commission's Secretariat at <u>Clerk 2</u> (Clerk typist), <u>Clerk 3</u> (Clerk stenographer), <u>Clerk 4</u> (Senior Stenographer), <u>Editor 2</u> (Editorial Assistant), <u>Administrative Officer 7</u> (Assistant Executive Secretary) and <u>Senior Officer 1</u> (Executive Secretary). These classifications were based on an appraisal by the Classification Branch of the Civil Service of Canada of job descriptions and salary classifications for employees of the Secretariat.

In 1966, the Canadian Government announced considerable changes in the classification standards and the application of the standards to positions in the Public Service. At the request of the Executive Secretary the Canadian Civil Service in their letter of 20 February 1967 has evaluated the ICNAF positions under the new system as follows:

The schedule of revised salaries for the new classifications is shown in Appendix 1. Altered rates of pay for the above classes and grades became effective for the Administrative Services and Information Services under Canadian Government Treasury Board minute 659668 dated 8 September 1966 and for the Elerical and Regulatory Services and the Secretarial, Stenographic and Typing Services under Canadian Government Treasury Board minute 653575 dated 4 May 1966. The appendix shows Canadian salary revisions effective 1 October 1965 (interim), 1 October 1965 (final) and 1 October 1966 as they relate to the exployees of the Commission Secretariat.

The following table provides a detailed summary of the salary item of the Preliminary Budget Estimate 1967/68 and Preliminary Budget Forecast 1968/69 (see Appendices I and II to the Agenda of the Standing Committee on Finance & Administration.)
