Annual Returns of Infringements, 1966

By the ICNAF Secretariat

Returns (to 16 May 1967) relating to mesh size, mesh obstructions and excess landing for 1966 were received from all Contracting Governments except Denmark, Germany (Fed. Rep.), Iceland and Poland.

This document presents a summary of inspections, infringements and actions taken by Contracting Governments as a result of their efforts to ensure adherence by their nationals to the Commission's trawl regulations.

After reporting the summary of infringements for 1965 (ICNAF Comm. Doc. 66-4) reports were received from France and Poland.

In 1965 Poland performed 42 inspections in harbour relating to mesh size and 9 inspections relating to mesh obstruction, while France performed, in harbour, 269 inspections relating to mesh size and 252 inspections relating to mesh obstruction. No infringements were reported by Poland or France in 1965.

Denmark did not report on infringements for 1965.
