**Canadian Salmon Statistics**

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The following 12 tables extend and replace catch data given in ICES/ICNAF Salmon Document 66-5 (ICNAF Serial No. 1643) and ICNAF Research Document 67/94 (ICNAF Serial No. 1891).

The data series is as complete as possible for recent years, but it will be noted that the period of years covered varies from one table to another. Data for unlisted earlier years are available for some of the tabulations, but time did not permit extraction from various sources for inclusion in this document.

Tables 1 and 2 list Canadian commercial catches in total, and by Provinces (Table 2). Tables 3-7 give monthly breakdowns of these catches. Small amounts taken in New Brunswick inland fisheries districts (less than 50 tons annually since 1950) are not included in Tables 3 and 5. Table 8 shows Newfoundland and Labrador angling catches, with a breakdown by weight categories as available. Table 9 lists New Brunswick and Nova Scotia angling catches. Tables 10-12 present angling catches in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Quebec by months for the most recent 5-year period for which data are available.

Total commercial catches for Canada, reported in ICNAF Statistical Bulletins and reports of the ICES/ICNAF Joint Working Party are not usually in agreement. In each case, it appears that the catch data submitted were early provisional data, subject to minor revisions (A. Proulx, personal communication), and neither series is in complete agreement with final figures published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. The latter figures have been used in the commercial catch tabulations presented here.

I am grateful to Mr. A. Proulx, Chief of the Economic Intelligence and Statistics Division, Canada Department of Fisheries and Forestry, for advice concerning the most reliable commercial catch data series, and for provision of estimated 1969 catches. Data for Tables 5, 6, 7, 10 and 11 were tabulated by Mr. C. Wykes, Resource Development Branch, Department of Fisheries and Forestry, Halifax. Mr. B. Tétreault of the Quebec Department of Tourism, Game and Fisheries provided the data of Table 12.
