PROPOSED TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE

STANDING COMMITTEE ON INTERNATIONAL CONTROL (STACTIC)

That the following paragraph be added to Commission Rules of Procedure 6

"6.5 There shall be a Standing Committee on International Control consisting of one nominee from each Contracting Government who may be assisted by experts or advisers, and of observers from non-Contracting Governments and from the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, the North-East Atlantic Fisheries Commission, and the European Economic Community. The Committee shall: (a) review the results of national and international measures of control; (b) develop inspection methodologies; (c) consider the practical problems of international measures of control; (d) review reports of inspections and violations; (e) promote exchanges and cooperative efforts of inspectors in international inspection; (f) make appropriate recommendations to the Commission. The Committee shall choose its own Chairman. The Executive Secretary shall be an ex officio member of this Committee without vote."
