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Sealing Statistics for the Northwest Atlantic - 1976

Reports on sealing catch and effort in the Northwest Atlantic in 1976 have been received from Canada and Norway for the "Front" and "Gulf" areas. Danish seal catches in Subarea 1 are not usually available at this time but are received in time for inclusion in the tables prior to their publication in the Research Bulletin. Table 1 contains all available information on harp and hooded seal catches, as well as the catches of other species of seals, for the calendar year 1976. Table 2 contains the corresponding statistics on seal hunting effort. It should be noted that Norwegian statistics for harp seals do not distinguish between "bedlamer" and "old harp" (Table 1), and that some effort data are lacking (as indicated by ... in Table 2) for Canada.
